Ideas to Help Your Child Do Better at School

Homework: Try playing "Beat the Clock" with your child during homework time. Look over the assignment and figure out about how long it should take to complete it. Allow a little extra time and set a timer for that many minutes. No prizes are needed. There is great satisfaction in getting the work done on time. Have a regular place for your child to do homework. Use a desk or table in a quiet room. Be sure there's plenty of light. Find a regular time for homework. You may want to make a rule: "No television until homework is finished."

- During homework time, turn off the TV and radio.
- Set a good example. While your child is doing homework, spend some time reading or working yourself. Then when homework is done, you can both talk about how much you've accomplished.
