Word Work for the Week:

Each child should know how to read and write these high frequency words: **animal, both, talk, those, and walk.**

We will be learning about comparative words. Students should be able to read and write: prettiest, hottest, bigger, rounder, and earliest.

Encourage keeping a journal. This is an excellent writing practice as well as a good outlet for venting feelings. Encourage your child to write about things that happen at home and school, about people (s)he likes or dislikes. Children can write about things to remember or things the child wants to do. Especially encourage your child to write about

disappointments. If the child wants to share the journal with you, read the entries and discuss them--especially the child's ideas and perceptions.

Keeping Kids Motivated:

Be a good role model. Demonstrate that learning and hard work is valued.

Offer support. Insincere praise or praise for poor efforts is no help, but children need to be reassured that they can do something.

Find strengths and build on them. Every child can shine in some area. Identify what your child does best, no matter what it is.


